# Desert Walks


Weekly "Desert Walks" featuring plants and wild life on the Salt River, will begin on November 15th, There is no charge for this activity which is offered by the Mesa Ranger District Volunteer Program.




The walks will be held every Tuesday at 10 a.m., alternating between two meeting locations : the Pebble Beach Rec. Site for odd Tuesdays of the month, and the Phon D Sutton location scheduled for meeting on even Tuesday dates.



 The walks are on easy terrain and usually last about an hour and a half. Sun protection and comfortable walking shoes are advised, as well as a walking stick if desired.

## Directions to the sites for Desert Walks:

From Mesa, take Power Road north (Power Road becomes the Bush Highway). PhonD Sutton turns off to the west. For the Pebble Beach site, go further north and turn off to the east.

From Fountain Hills, take Highway 87 north and turn right on the Bush Highway. Go past Saguaro Lake and turn left (east) into the Pebble Beach site. The PhonD Sutton site is further south and turns off to the right (west).
